- **ENTRY FEES ARE \$25 PER CLASS UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.**
- A \$5 fee per exhibitor will be charged to cover the expense of having an EMT On the grounds.
- **SCHOOLING** will be permitted only in areas provided. No schooling except as a ticketed session. Tickets are \$10.00. All horses/ponies not showing will be charged \$25 for schooling.
- **BAYMAR FARMS MEMBERSHIP IS NOT MANDATORY BUT REQUIRED TO QUALIFY FOR BAYMAR FARMS YEAR END SERIES AWARDS. MEMBERSHIP FEE IS \$35**
- **MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes should the best interests of the show or the rules require it.
- All pets to be kept on a leash.
- **BAYMAR FARMS INC., ITS OWNER OR THOSE CONNECTED WITH THE SHOW WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE, INJURY OR LOSS TO ANY PERSON, ANIMAL OR PROPERTY OF EXHIBITOR OR SPECTATORS.**

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NONMEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

MOTOR VEHICLE STATEMENT

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.
